Dove's Domestic Violence Program provides comprehensive assistance and support to families affected by domestic violence. The program serves five counties – Macon, Moultrie, Piatt, Shelby and DeWitt. Services include 24-hour hotlines, a Shelter located in Macon County for victims and their children, individual and group counseling, legal advocacy, and children's programming.

State and Federal funds support most of the domestic violence services (Department of Human Services, Illinois Attorney General Funds, VOCA, Illinois Criminal Justice, and 708 Board) and the United Way. Other matching and supportive funds are through donations of area congregations and individuals dedicated to the mission of Dove programs.

As we meet each funding source's requirement, the laws of Illinois and guidelines of ICADV, we cannot forget the added plus given to the program for its location at Dove. Dove's faith-based leadership means always compassionate, always empathetic, and the sensitive delivery of services.

Dove's dedication to being an organization for volunteers to make a difference in the lives of others and themselves makes this a remarkable program to join.
